Why is it named Britomart?

Governor Hobson was on the Royal Navy gunship, HMS Britomart, when she anchored in Auckland in 1840 at the original peninsula at the junction of what today is Quay St and Kings Wharf. Hobson's colleagues on board carried out a detailed survey of the Waitemata Harbour and the ship's name was bestowed on the peninsula: Britomart Point. Britomart was subsequently gifted by Ngati Whatua to Governor Hobson for the construction of a new capital city. Most of Britomart was under water until the 1870s, when the point was demolished with the fill used to reclaim the current Britomart site. Many of the offices built during the early 1900s have now been refurbished and we are lucky enough to be occupying one of these.
